A Brief History

St. Cyprian's, which was initially known as the Anglican Church at Finch and Leslie, began in a portable in 1965. In 1968, we and two other churches, Iona Presbyterian and Hillcrest United, joined together to erect the current facility at 1080 Finch Ave East. We moved into what became known as the Tri--Church building in 1970.
